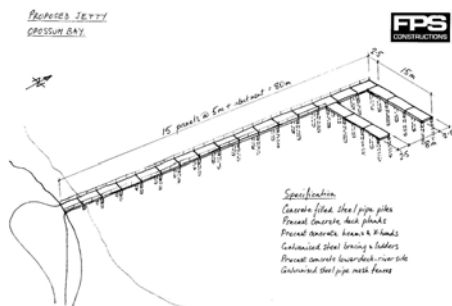

Imagine Opossum Bay without its jetty ....

Last night we attended the first round of MAST Recreational Boating Fund meetings. Some 40 people attended and all were given the opportunity to “sell” their case. Our team was well prepared and given sufficient time to present a detailed overview of the new jetty.

The old jetty was due to be removed before the end of this year. However, when questioned over its removal, MAST indicated that this may be delayed until sometime next year. In addition to website information, this will allow us to place banners between pylons and notify visitors of its forthcoming removal (this summer).

We also submitted our second submission under the Tasmania Community Fund (TCF). In the accompanying business plan we placed great emphasis for future jetty use to extend well beyond the South Arm Peninsula community. After all, and since its original introduction in 1889, the jetty enjoyed extensive commercial use. If we were to concentrate on local jetty use only, we very much doubt if the Tasmanian government would show any interest in helping to fund our project.



If there were a prize for being the most original fundraiser, this would have to go to a family in South Arm who is prepared to setup a barbie on the jetty over the summer months.
