The new jetty will not only be for us at SAP but also Hobart population at large. After all, we address a badly needed safety issue

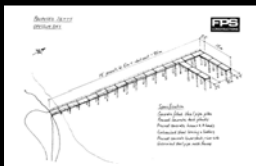
