We will even have a special media marquee, fondly named "OB1-can-opy". BBQ's, Ice-cream vans, Hamburger Stands? *You bet'cha!*

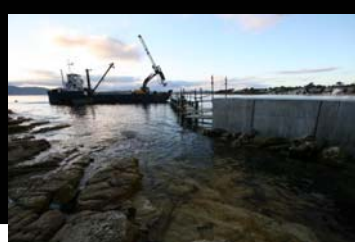
